INFORMATION CONCERNING THIS SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship award is a gift from the Alpha Omega of Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority, Scott City, Kansas; and as a sacred trust, is used for students who maintain a high scholastic standing and who could not attend college without financial assistance.

- Any student attending a Kansas College or Technical School, and a graduate of SCHS or home school within Scott County will be considered; need not be a graduating senior. Applicants are eligible to receive a scholarship from Alpha Omega no more than two times.

In consideration of applicants, the committee will give special consideration to the following:

1. Leadership: Initiative, organizational ability, and influence on others.
2. Scholastic Achievement.
3. Personality: Ability to meet people and get along harmoniously with them.
4. Perseverance and Resourcefulness: As exemplified by your record in school, church, community, sports, etc.
5. Sense of Honor: Integrity, honesty, sportsmanship, and general character.
6. Financial Need.
7. Plans for the future.

The application forms must be completely filled out, and must include the following:

1. An un-mounted photo (senior picture or something current).
2. A high school transcript (college if attending).
3. An autobiographical sketch of at least 200 words (what you are about and what you want to do with your life).
4. One recommendation from a minister, teacher, present or former employer, or coach.
