## 2. Presentations:

- A. Everett Green made a presentation on behalf of EMC insurance for schools. Our school district received a dividend of \$15,645.00 from EMC. This was the first time Mr. Green had seen EMC give dividends to schools.

1. Andy Trout attended the High Plains Educational Cooperation meeting in October and shared with BOE members

- 2. Andrew Trout attended the State BOE conference in Overland Park. He shared information on the breakout sessions he attended. Mr. Trout shared information on special education funding.
- 3. Julia Cheney attended the NWKT met in October at Quinter. Mrs. Cheney shared they toured the welding facility in Quinter.

## B. Administrative Reports

- Dr. Shawn Roberts shared students have been donating coins during the
  past month. The money collected has been donated to Quilts of Valor.
  The money will be used to purchase sewing supplies. Quilts of Valor
  makes and donates quilts to area veterans. A quilt was presented to a
  local veteran during the Veteran's program. Dr. Roberts also shared
  about the staff will share their passion with students this month.
- 2. Mr. David Dirks gave an update on the Chrome Books with students in the middle and high schools. No major concerns at this point. District has a little over 1,500 devices. There have been more breaks with the Chrome Books. Possible reason could be a larger number of students using the Chrome Books. Mr. Dirks said they have been able to complete the updates on the Chrome Books much better this year. The individual teacher to set his or her own perimeters is now doing classroom management.

This fall the district was able to complete the project at the football field, maintenance building, and concession stand of adding those areas with the fiber network. The project was funded 90% through e-rate. This next year, e-rate will be funding the wireless controller at around 70% and looks to run around \$40,000.

Wireless projectors have been positively received at the middle school. Mr. Dirks is looking at purchasing more wireless projectors or updating the projectors that we have located in the elementary and high schools to become wireless.

- 3. Mrs. Jana Irvin shared the middle school has been hit with sickness. Today about 10% of our students and 6 teachers.
- 4. Mr. Dustin Hughes shared numbers with basketball. Numbers in girls' basketball continue to be up and are going to have a C team. SCMS will host GWAC wrestling.
- 5. Mr. Matt Bayer shared that all students that were eligible to take the WorkKeys and PreACT have completed it. Students have been able to complete a couple of college visits with Mrs. Price. Musical went well. Mr. Bayer shared he was glad to see Mr. Thornburg's students helped build the set for the musical. He hopes to see more student involvement in future years.
- Mr. Aaron Dirks Fall seasons have wrapped up their seasons. Tennis, Golf, and Cross Country had athletes compete at the state level. The Tennis doubles teams placed 7<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and the team placed 5th. Cross-

Country had an athlete place 9<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Dirks shared that he has made a practice schedule for the gym. He is working on fall sports schedules. Great numbers for boys and girls basketball, wrestling and we have 7 girls out for wrestling.

7. Superintendent Jamie Rumford shared information on our graduation rates. Our district received a gold star for High School Graduation, a bronze star for Post-Secondary success, and a copper star for Acadmically Prepared for Post-Secondary. Mr. Rumford shared information on the automotive classes that could be added to SCHS next year through GCCC. Students from Dighton and Leoti have expressed interest in participating in these classes/program. He also shared pictures of the progress of the bus barn. This week is American Education.

  motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Dr. Roberts also shared that the building is using SWANK, a movie licensing company for schools use and not be in violation of copyright laws.
- Discussion on how to handle students outside our district attending special events. Mr. Rumford was asked to bring language at next meeting

## E. COVID Response Update

- 1. As of today 10 students and 4 staff in our district today with COVID. Many more with flu and other sicknesses.
- 2. It is much harder this year trying to contact trace students coming in contact with someone testing positive with COVID. Mr. Rumford would like to change our plan and send a weekly message/update to the parents in our district with an update of COVID. - 4. Calling off School in the past we have let school out for state competitions. Mr. Rumford shared with the BOE that there may come a time when we will need to call off school due to illness with staff and not being able to have enough substitutes.
