

Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Education, Unified School District No. 466, 704 S. College Street, Scott City, Kansas, Wednesday, March 1, 2017, 704 S. College St., Board Mtg. Room, 5:00 P.m.

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The Board of Education of Unified School District No. 466 met in special session on Wednesday, March 1, 2017, at 5:00 P.M., in the Administration Building Board Meeting Room, 704 S. College Street, Scott City, KS, with the following members present:

Others present were Jamie Rumford, Superintendent; Jana Irvin and Shawn Roberts, Building Administrators, Rod Haxton, Editor of Scott County Record, and Susan Carter, board clerk.

President Chris Price called the meeting to order.

**Discussion with Gibson, Mancini, Carmichael & Nelson Architects**

Stuart Nelson and Nick Nemecheck, GMCN Architects, were in attendance to discuss facility upgrades. The purpose of the special meeting was to accomplish three goals: get everyone caught up on conversations; make a decision on timeline; and discuss the impact on mill levies. Past, present and future enrollment figures were also discussed. Charts representing the high school, middle school, elementary school, district office, football/sports complex, community center, bond vote timeline, bond costs 20 year duration, and bond costs 25 year duration were displayed. Board members were given stickers in various colors to prioritize their thoughts on the district's needs listed on each chart. Mark Davis requested information on current mill levies and timelines on other community projects to help in the decision making of the board. The charts were reviewed and discussed. GMCN will bring the results from the discussion to the board meeting on March 6<sup>th</sup>.

Leann Wiechman made a motion to adjourn. Mark Davis seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:57 p.m.
