As of September 3, 2020 (last week), Scott County Schools is able to offer **FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH** to **ALL** enrolled students! Funding for this comes from the USDA, so it comes at no cost to the school district. It is likely this funding will last until December, so it will eventually run out. Nonetheless, we are happy our students and families can benefit from it throughout the fall months!

It is important to note that extra milk or items from the ala carte menu will have a price attached. These extra items are not covered by the USDA funding.

Although no paperwork is required from parents to participate, it is still important that families complete the Free and Reduced Lunch Applications included with enrollment paperwork. Families who qualify for free or reduced lunches will benefit when the USDA funding runs out. Free and Reduced funding also provides the school district with resources necessary to help our students.
