4) Each student must be in good standing with his or her school.

5) Cost of Drivers Education Class is \$220 per student

6) <u>Student must pass a Drivers Education Course to be eligible to apply for a restricted</u> <u>license at age 15 if not qualifying for a farm permit.</u>
