Holcomb Unified School District 363 is to provide an opportunity for all students to acquire skills needed to become productive and successful citizens.

- We ask that all fans practice social distancing except if they are from the same family unit. If this isn't possible, we ask that fans wear a mask
- We ask fans not to socialize in large groups before, during and after the game
- Elementary and middle school students are asked to practice social distancing before/during/after the contest. For example no large groups of students playing football or other games in the concession area or on any areas surrounding the football field. If this cannot be accomplished, students will be asked to sit in the stands with parents or in their age groups.
- Fans are asked to stay off the field after games and to not socialize in large groups after the game has been completed.

Concession: A concession stand will be provided but with limited offerings. We will only have prepackaged food available.

Participants: **We ask the following guidelines be followed by participants**

- Players coaches, and managers practice social distancing as much as possible
- Teams traveling to our facility will be asked to take their players temperature before arriving
- Masks are required to enter into the building prior to the contests
- Teams are asked to leave the field immediately after post game talk
