COLBY INVITATIONAL

1. Tournament will follow all USGA Rules unless otherwise stated in the following rules.
2. Varsity golfers will play from the RED TEES on the front 9 and the WHITE TEES on the back 9. You will play 9 holes before you switch tees.
3. Golfers will be allowed to play the ball up within a **card's length** of where it lies (no closer to the hole) everywhere on the golf course except in hazards, sand traps, and on greens. This rule allows golfers to play the ball up in the rough and in grass traps. Golfers may lift and place the ball within a card's length.
4. We will play a 10-stroke limit on all holes.
5. **Out of bounds** is marked with white stakes and lines. **Hazards** are marked with red stakes and lines. Pay attention to the out of bounds behind hole #6. The out of bounds is marked by the white stakes and lines in front of the cart path and is **NOT** the split rail white fence behind the cart path.
 - **Out of bounds-** Right of 1, 2, 3, & 6
Behind green on 1, 5, & 6.
Where marked around clubhouse.
 - **Hazards-** 6, 8, & 9.
6. **Hole Number 6-** The waste bunker to the right of Hole Number 6 is rocky in places! If you hit your ball in there, you will have 2 options:

Option #1: Play the ball out of the waste bunker. It plays as rough so you can play the ball up in there and ground your club.

Option #2: Drop the ball in the drop circle that is located in the right rough with **no penalty**. May gain or lose distance!

7. If there is a question as to a ruling, play a second ball and keep score for both balls. A rules committee made up of the attending coaches will make a ruling on the issue in question. Do not sign your cards until a ruling has been made.
8. You will trade cards with a person in your group and keep each other's score. Both the player and the person who kept the score will sign the scorecard before it is turned in.
9. Golfers, coaches, and spectators are asked to maintain social distancing as much as possible.
10. We will award medals in an outdoors, no contact ceremony at the conclusion of play. Masks will be required during the awards ceremony.
11. Players, coaches, and spectators will only be allowed in the clubhouse to use the restroom and take refreshments to go. **Masks** are required in the clubhouse.

Girls Golf:

General:

1. All KSHSAA Sports Specific Recommendations will be followed.
2. This policy was written with the safety of all participants in mind.
3. Hand sanitizer will be available in several locations throughout the facility.
4. Golfers will have their own equipment.
5. Driving range will be determined by the golf course.

6. If bad weather occurs, all should return to their vehicles rather than the clubhouse.
7. Teams traveling to our facility will be asked to take their player's temperatures before leaving their campus.
8. Maximize distance and limit groups on one hole/area as much as possible.
9. We will utilize a shotgun start to get all competitors out on the course at one time.
10. Athletes will provide their own water bottle.
11. Spectators will be allowed. They should have physical distance and masks are highly recommended.
12. Participants will wear masks in the clubhouse.
13. Participants will develop and utilize an appropriate sign of respect and sportsmanship.
