- Where: Forewinds Municipal Golf Course (3 miles west of Hugoton on HWY 51)
- Parking: We will have a designated area for bus & spectator parking.
- HS Schools: Bucklin, Cimarron, Deerfield, Elkhart, Fowler, Holcomb, Lakin, Liberal, Meade, South Gray, Satanta, Scott City, Stanton County, Sublette, & Ulysses.
- MS Schools: Bucklin, Cimarron, Elkhart, Fowler, Garden City-Horace Good, Garden City-Kenneth Henderson, Holcomb, SW Heights, Lakin, Liberal Eisenhower, Liberal Seymour Rogers, Meade, South Gray, Satanta, Scott City, Stanton County, Sublette, & Ulysses.
- Team Camps:** Please spread out across the golf course so that we can maintain physical distance between teams.
- Entry Fee: Middle School entry fee is \$35 per team or \$7 per individual if less than 5 runners. Boys and girls are separate teams. (\$70 max per school).
- High School entry fee is \$50 per team or \$10 per individual if less than 5 runners. Boys and girls are separate teams. (\$100 max per school).
- Schedule: Coaches Meeting at 8:15 a.m. at the starting line.

- Races are on a rolling schedule – we will get the next race started as soon as we can.
- Masks:** We will use a mass start for all races. Athletes are required to wear a mask, gaiter, or appropriate face covering at the starting line and until the 400m mark of the race. At that point (will be marked), runners may pull their covering down. Please, if possible, have the runners wear their covering around their necks for the rest of the race as opposed to dropping them on the course.
- It is highly recommended that spectators, coaches, & athletes wear masks while at the meet.
- Finish Chute:** All teams must have a coach or volunteer from their team helping their athletes move through the finishing chute.
- Awards: Medals will be awarded to the top runners in each division.
MS – Top 15. JV Girls – Top 10. JV Boys – Top 15. Varsity – 20.
Team medals (7) will be given to the top 3 varsity teams.
- There will not be an awards ceremony. Coaches please pick-up your medals in the clubhouse after the meet.



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- Entries: We will be using electronic timing this year. See the attached document on how to enter your athletes. Please have your entries completed by noon on Thursday, Sept. 17th.
- Fruit/Water: We will not provide any water or fruit for the runners this year. Each team will need to provide their own.
- Restrooms: There will be restroom facilities in the clubhouse for coaches. Athletes will need to use the porta potties located outside. No athletes should be inside the clubhouse at any time.
- Misc: There will be a hospitality room for coaches and bus drivers inside the clubhouse.

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Game Day Operations

General:

- We will do our best to follow KSHSAA Sport Specific recommendations.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in locations throughout the facility.

Spectators:

- Spectators will be allowed at all activities.
- Spectators are asked to social distance (at least six feet) or to sit in family clusters.
- Masks are not required but are highly recommended.
- Spectators are asked to social distance in the concession line.
- Please make sure children are sitting with parents/guardians and not running around the facility.
- Spectators are asked to not socialize in large groups before, during, or after the contest.

Workers:

- Event workers are required to wear masks.
- People handling food and/or money are encouraged to wear gloves.

Coaches/Participants:

- Players, coaches, and managers will practice social distancing when possible.
- Teams traveling to our facility will be asked to take their players' temperatures before leaving their campus.
- Masks are highly recommended to be worn by all of the above while in our locker rooms and facilities.
- After the game, a sign of sportsmanship will be given by each team. How that will be displayed will be determined by each team prior to the game. Players are not to shake hands with the opposing team.
