COVID "Game Day" Expectations & Protocols

TENNIS:

1. Visiting Teams will do temperature checks prior to loading busses for away activities.
2. Please remind your players to social distance themselves from other players/parents/teams (6-feet apart). If they are unable to social distance, please have them wear a mask.
3. Please have your players wash their hands and disinfect their tennis racquet handles after each match.
 - We will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant. However, it would be a good idea if you also brought some with you for your own teams to use.
4. Bring your own water coolers to the meet. We will not be providing water coolers for your players to refill with.
5. We will provide all warm-up balls.
6. Upon your team's arrival, we will present each coach/team with the format for the day and 8-tennis balls that will be pre-marked with each school's initials PB for Phillipsburg, etc).
 - Please give each of your singles players/doubles team's 2-tennis balls. These tennis balls will be used by your players for each match for the entire day.
 - Players are to keep track of these tennis balls throughout the day.
 - During matches, players are only to handle their own designated tennis balls.
 - If a ball from your opponent's court or an adjacent court comes onto your court, please have your players use their racquet or feet to advance the ball to the other side of the court or adjacent courts.
 - At the conclusion of play for the day, there will be a designated hopper for all players to place their tennis balls to be disinfected.
7. At the beginning of a match, players/teams need to choose which side of the net posts (right or left) that they will place their racquet bags, drinks, etc. on. When changing sides of the court, players/teams will always need to change ends on the side of the net post in which their racquets, bags, drinks, etc. are on. This will aid us with social distancing.
8. We will not be using our Score Posts, so your players will need to remember the scores throughout the match and announce the set score at the beginning of each game/set.
9. At the conclusion of a match, please inform your players to NOT SHAKE HANDS with their opponent/opponents. Instead, have them use an appropriate sign of respect and sportsmanship (i.e. wave, head nod, or racket clap) and tell their opponent/opponents "Nice match!".

Spectator Expectations and Procedures

Tennis

- Masks are required for entry into the building, and must be worn at all events when social distancing (6') cannot be maintained.
- Spectators should sit as family cohorts and social distance.
- Spectators will not be allowed near participant groups, or on fields/courts. Only essential personnel will be allowed near participant groups.
- Hand sanitizer will be located throughout the venue.
- There are currently no restrictions for attendance.
