Acquire the basic knowledge and skills necessary to meet the psychosocial, physical, and environmental needs of patients, clients, and residents. CNAs provide a number of services such as bathing, feeding and measuring vital signs. You may work in a long-term care facility, hospital, doctor's office or other facility. HHAs can seek employment with a home health agency to care for patients from infants to adults in the home. Health care is one of the country's fastest growing industries, making this career not only personally rewarding but also in high demand.
